Important information in regards to nominations

Honorary members: An honorary member is a **retired** person whom the SAPBA wants to honour as a result of the specific person's particular services to and promotion of the objectives of the SAPBA **and/or** because of his or her exceptional achievements as plant breeder. Honorary members enjoy all the privileges of ordinary members but are exempt from the paying of membership fees. Honorary members are not eligible for selection to the management.

Fellow Award: A Fellow is a person whom is **still active** as a plant breeder and whom the SAPBA wants to honour as a result of the specific person's outstanding services to and promotion of the SAPBA **and** because of his or her exceptional contributions to Plant Breeding in southern Africa in research or teaching or extension services over an extended period of time. The nominee must have at least ten (10) years of uninterrupted membership of SAPBA. Fellow members enjoy all the privileges of ordinary members.

Election of honorary and fellow members:

- Written nominations with motivations must be signed by a proposer and seconder, both of whom must be members in good standing of the SAPBA.
- The nomination must be submitted to the President of the SAPBA.
- Nominations shall be adjudicated by the SAPBA executive committee. Decisions of this committee will be final and no correspondence regarding these shall be entered into.
- No single award shall be made to the same person twice.
